Abolishment of the Thesis Requirement

The students' opinions are considered for the improvement of the relevance and utility of the courses in line with their expectations, taking into account the trends in the International Job Market.

Taking into account:

- Employed students, constituting approximately 40% of the enrolled students.
- The large number of active students who have not presented a thesis from 2016 to 2021 (a sample survey was conducted considering workload/family obligations).
- Immediate professional placement of graduates (2022 graduate absorption survey), mainly in the private sector.
- Collaboration with ACCA and international employment opportunities.

The program proceeded with the abolition of the thesis requirement $1838/22/\Gamma\Pi/31-1-2022$, published in the Government Gazette 778/21-2-2022/Issue~B. It was replaced by courses contributing to professional directions such as Accountant and Certified Auditor Accountant.

It offered the exclusive option for the academic year 2022-23, instead of completing a thesis, for active students enrolled in the academic years 2016-2021 to attend and successfully complete courses in collaboration with two other postgraduate programs of the School of Economics and Business, specifically "Applied Economics" and/or "Sustainable Accounting, Financial Management, and Governance."
